<p>Brief Overview</p>	<p>The Troop Activities Leader is responsible for ensuring the Troop members are fully aware of arrangements for activities at the Jamboree and are appropriately prepared for these activities.</p>
<p>Specific Duties</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to the Jamboree, assist with mixing activities in Troop get togethers • Attend the Line Leaders Training and Planning Weekend, August 2018 • With the Scouts plan a gateway and organise the transport of any decorations for it. Pioneer poles only are provided for you on site • Design and supervise the erection of troop gateway • Once at the Jamboree, familiarise yourself with site layout and the activity rotations, then promote and assist all Scouts' prompt and positive involvement in these activities. This is your first priority. • Monitor youth achievement toward the Jamboree Award • Liaise with Camping Ground and Activity staff as necessary • Ensure troop members are wearing clothes or Jamboree uniform appropriate to their activity • Arrange any special activities within the troop (including pre booking of activities where necessary) • Co-ordinate the participation of any of your line leaders in the youth program as and where necessary • Duties as requested by Troop Leader
