<p>Brief Overview</p>	<p>The Troop Welfare Leader is responsible for ensuring the welfare and support of all troop members and obtaining appropriate levels of support from the Sub Camp or Contingent as required.</p>
<p>Specific Duties</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work with the other Leaders on the Troop site as a team • Attend the Line Leaders Training and Planning Weekend, August 2018 • Promote and if necessary intervene in the hygiene and welfare of troop members, both youth and Leaders. • Supervise medications of youth and leaders in troop. • Liaise with Contingent HQ in any cases where the Troop member's sickness/injury is of such a nature that they cannot be cared for in the troop. • Ensure the observation of all lawful instructions relating to fire protection and OHS requirements. • Maintain the Troop First Aid Kit. • Recognise personal problems (eg homesickness) and if necessary arrange support through Contingent Troop Support Director. • Ensure all troop Leaders receive adequate time off, and remind them to take time out. • Be aware of any Scout or Leader disabilities and how to care for them. • Other duties as requested by the Troop Leader. • Work with the Contingent Troop Support Team as required.
