

Below is the current kit list for the Woodhouse Activity site current as at 02-Sep-2018 There may be small variances to this list and any changes will be communicated to the contingent staff.

What do the scouts need to bring?

Hint! Think of this as an overnight hike

- An overnight bag to carry all of the below.
- The clothes you arrive at Woodhouse in will get muddy and wet during the day's activities, so dress for the day before leaving Main Site.
- Shoes must be covered from heel to toe, and protect your feet from stones and sticks.
- Bring change of shoes AND socks as the pair you wear to Woodhouse will get muddy and wet.
- Change of clothes to wear the next day, which will also double for dry clothes to wear in the evening.
- Include some layers of clothing for sleeping in. (clean socks always good idea)
- Include provision for hot, cold, and for wet weather.
- Day pack to carry things around at Woodhouse (Hat, Water bottle, maps etc)
- Sleeping bag, bed mat, and Pillow if you want
- Towel and Toiletries
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen
- Wide-brimmed hat
- Torch
- Any personal medications

- 1. All meals will be provided before departure from Main Site in an "AJ2019 Ration pack". This will contain everything you need for your meals, including cutlery. To be carried by you!
- 2. Woodhouse gets cold at night and early mornings even in summer. Avg low in January is 13°C, Avg Max is 25°C
- 3. With all of the above try to travel light, you need to be able to carry everything yourself, in a bus, and maybe 500m at Woodhouse
- 4. Each patrol will be provided 2 tents, 1 x 3 person and 1 x 4 person, to sleep in

- Day pack to carry things around at Woodhouse (Hat, Water bottle, maps etc)
- Sleeping bag, bed mat, and a Pillow if you want
- Towel and Toiletries
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen
- Wide-brimmed hat
- Torch
- Any personal medications
