Eligibility requirements for Scouts attending AJ2022



- Must be a current registered youth member at the time of application and through till at least January 14 2022.
- Must have met the requirements, before October 31 2021, for :
- Program Essentials Milestone one, as well as Outdoor Adventure Skills Stage three in Bushcraft, Bushwalking and Camping;
- Must have completed 10 nights camping in the outdoors with the Unit or Patrol, as a Scout. Three of those nights must be consecutive and camping with family or school is not considered.
- Have approval from the Unit Council
- · Have approval from the Contingent Leader
- Have consent from their parents/guardian
- Not have had their 15th birthday before the opening day of the Jamboree (i.e. under 15 years old on 3/1/2022)
